

- Legal Assistance Program – SCTDD contracts with the Legal Aid Society of Middle Tennessee and the Cumberlandts to provide legal assistance to older individuals. Title III-B funds in the amount of \$36,500 assisted 125 clients.
- Senior Citizens Centers – The 12 county Senior Citizens Centers provided 415,582 units of service to 13,616 persons. Funding for all these programs

totalled \$246,171.

- SCTDD/AAAD Staff continues to participate in Regional Senior Olympics, the Senior Expo, Health Council, the Adult Abuse Coalition Conference and October Fraud Awareness Month, the Senior Center Directors’ Association, and county health fairs.
